Class of 2018 Facts & Comparisons

**CLASS OF 2018:** The forty-five graduating seniors of the Class of 2018 perpetuate Orangeburg Prep's legacy of academic excellence. <u>Thirteen</u> students were recognized by the South Carolina Independent School Association as SCISA Honor Graduates for having scored at least 1100 on the SAT and obtaining a 3.5 grade point average for each of seven semesters. And, <u>twenty-two</u> students graduated with high honors which means they have a cumulative grade point average of 4.0 or higher, while <u>fourteen</u> students earned Life Scholarship. Furthermore, Orangeburg Prep has <u>three</u> students receiving the Palmetto Fellows Award. To receive the Palmetto a student must score at least 1200 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT, earn a cumulative 3.5 GPA, and rank in the top six percent of their class. A student who is not in the top six percent of his/her class may earn the Palmetto by scoring either 1400 on the SAT <u>or</u> 32 on the ACT <u>and</u> earn a cumulative 4.0 GPA. Among colleges and universities that our graduates will attend are Charleston Southern University, Clemson Bridge, Clemson University, College of Charleston, Georgia State University, Lander, LSU, Midlands Technical College, Newberry College, O-C Technical College, Pontificia Universidad Javeriana - Cali, Presbyterian College, Savannah College of Art and Design, The Citadel, The Citadel - Honors, University of Alabama, University of South Carolina, University of South Carolina - Aiken, University of South Carolina - Honors, and Wofford College.
